

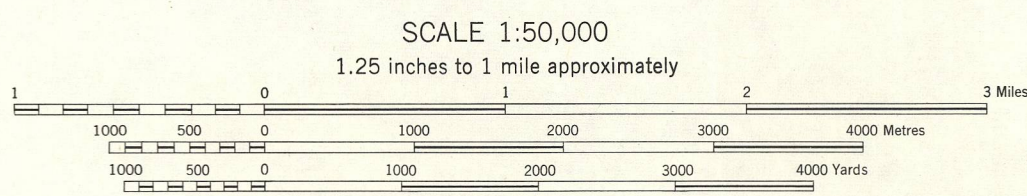

Annual magnetic change 2' easterly

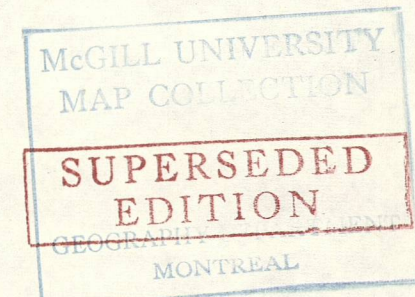
