At the meeting of the Council of the Oneida of the Thames Band held here on May 6th, 1941, I was requested by that body to secure from the Department six copies of the Rules and Regulations of that Band which were passed some years ago in accordance with Section, 110 of the Indian Act.

There have been a number of disputes among Oneida ^Band members concerning the erection and maintenance of line fences and neither the Council nor this office have a copy of the Rules and Regulations of this Band. There is at this office a copy of the Regulations of the Muncey Band only and I have been using these Regulations as being applicable to the Oneida and Chippewa Reserves as well but would much prefer to have the Regulations of the Oneida Band as requested by their Council.
