CLARKE, Lieut.-Col. CHARLES, J.P. (East Wellington.

B. in Lincoln, Eng., 28 Nov. 1826. Ed. at Waddington, Lincolnshire, under Mr. George Boole, afterwards Prof. of Mathematics in Queen's Coll., Cork. M., 1st, June, 1852, Emma, dau. of Jas. Kent, Esq., Selkirk, Ont.; 2nd, 1881, Rose Helen, dau. of Jas. Halley, Esq., Ponsonby, Ont. Came to Can. in 1844 and engaged in farming. Was Reeve of Elora for several years. Edited the Journal and Express (Hamilton) from 1848 to 1850, and the Backwoodsman (Elora) for some years.
