

from 1837 to 1854. Was Presdt. of Municipal Council, New Westminster, 1863, and twice afterwards. Was a mem. of Ex. Council from Nov., 1871 to Dec., 1872, and held the office of Chief Commissioner of Lands and Works from first date until 15 Jan., 1872, and that of Presdt. of Ex. Council subsequently until resignation of Cabinet, 20 Dec., 1872. Represented Douglas and Lillooet in first Legislative Council of B.C., 1864-65-66, and held a seat, by nomination of Crown, in the United Legislature of B. C. and Vt. from 1868 until confederation with Can. was carried, 1870. Returned for present seat, by acclamation, at g.e., 1871.—*Columbia St., New Westminster.*
