An Act to abolish the Registry Office established at the Village of Durham in the County of Beauharnois, and to establish two Registry Offices, one at the Village of Beauharnois and the other at the Village of Huntingdon, in the said County.

WHEREAS the Inhabitants of the County of Beauharnois Preamble. have suffered much inconvenience from there being only one Registry Office in a County of so great extent, and the population whereof is so considerable; And whereas these inconveniences would be avoided by the establishment of two Registry Offices for the said County, at suitable places therein, the one in the upper or southern portion of the County, and the other in the lower or northern portion; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That from and after the one thousand eight hundred and the Registry Office for the County of Beauharnois shall be no longer held at the Village of Durham.

II. And be it enacted, That upon, from and after the day of one thousand eight hundred and fifty the said County of Beauharnois shall for the County divide 15 purposes of Registration of Deeds and Titles be divided into two ed into two Registration Registration Districts, to be known respectively as Number One and Districts. Number Two; the Registration District Number One of the said County shall comprise and consist of the Seigniory of Beauharnois, 20 and the Registry Office for the same shall be kept at the Village of Beauharnois; And the Registration District Number Two of the said County shall comprise and consist of all the remaining portion of the said County, and the Registry Office for the same shall be kept at the Village of Huntingdon; and each of the said Registration 25 Districts shall, for all purposes relative to the Registration of Deeds and Titles, be regarded as if it were a distinct County.

III. And be it enacted, That the present Registrar of Deeds for Present Rethe said County of Beauharnois shall be the first Registrar for the gistrar contained in Discretization District Number aforesaid, and shall hold office trict No.
