Instructions to sue or defend, Two Shillings and Six Pence ; Drawing Claim, Two Shillings and Six Pence ; Fee on every Writ or Order, One Shilling and Three Pence ; Common Affidavits One Shilling ; Common Notice or Appointment, One Shilling ; Every necessary Attendance, Six Pence ; Special Affidavits and other Special Documents, Eight Pence per folio ; Fee on Common Motions, One Shilling and Three Pence ; Copy of every paper when necessary, half the amount allowed for the Original ; Bill of Costs, One Shilling ; Postages actually paid. 15

Fee on Special Applications, Arguments, Hearings, &c., Ten Shillings, to be increased at the discretion of the Judge to Twenty-five Shillings.
