ling and Three Pence; return thereof, money made or party arrested, One Shilling and Three Pence; necessary mileage actually travelled, Four Pence per mile; and for other services, a sum to be fixed by Order of the Judge not exceeding the present allowance by Statute for similar services.

Instructions to sue or defend, Two Shillings and Six Pence; Drawing Claim, Two Shillings and Six Pence; Fee on every Writ or Order, One Shilling and Three Pence; Common Affidavits One Shilling; Common Notice or Appointment, One Shilling; Every necessary Attendance, Six Pence; Special 10 Affidavits and other Special Documents, Eight Pence per folio; Fee on Common Motions, One Shilling and Three Pence; Copy of every paper when necessary, half the amount allowed for the Original; Bill of Costs, One Shilling; Postages actually paid.

## COUNSEL.

Fee on Special Applications, Arguments, Hearings, &c., Ten Shillings, to be increased at the discretion of the Judge to Twenty-five Shillings.
