FIRST SESSION, FOURTH PARLIAMENT, 1852-3.

The number of PETITIONS received during the Session was 1621.

The number of SELECT COMMITTEES appointed was 126, of which the following is a detailed account, shewing the matters referred to the consideration of each Committee, and the day upon which a Report was made therefrom to the House; specifying when such Report was by Bill. Where nothing to the contrary is stated, it is to be understood that no Report was made.

- 1.—To prepare and report Lists of Members to compose the Standing Committees appointed by the House. *Report*, 23rd August.
- 2.—Standing Committee on Railroads, Canals, and Telegraph Lines.

No. 12.—To amend the Acts incorporating the Champlain and St. Lawrence Railway Company.

No. 15.—For the extension of the Montreal and New-York Railway.

No. 14.—To amend the Act incorporating the St. Lawrence and Atlantic Railway Company.

No. 107.—To incorporate the Provincial Grand Trunk Railway Company.

No. 89.—To authorize the Brantford and Buffalo Railway Company to construct a Railway from Fort Erie to Goderich.

No. 81.—To incorporate the Cobourg and Peterborough Railway Company.
