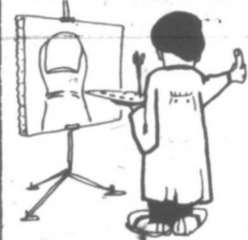

The death of a Mississauga couple Aug. 3 at Royal Windsor Drive and the South Service Road in Oakville has sparked a public investigation into the controversial corner.

An Oakville town committee will make a site inspection tonight (Wed.) at the scene and a former councillor has made a further request for a public investigation.

Uthlan Bartholomew, 62 and his wife Gladys, 59 of Balsam Road in Mississauga, died when their car collided with another vehicle at the dangerous corner.
