acre of ground an overcrowded condition, that for the last
100 years they never grew vegetables or owned a horse or a
cow at Rocky Point. The Department has provided two water
closets, but does not own the Spring where they get their water.
I enclose that report to the Dept. | The Superintendent
of Education wrote me asking me to make provision for the
education of the children there as they won't be admitted
to the white school, I don't know what to do. If I fail
in my duty there it won't be for lack of free advice.
