This involves the reconversion of the following units from infantry battalions, - 4th Princess Louise Dragoon Guards to a reconnaissance regiment, Westminster Regiment (notor) to a motor battalion, 1st Light Anti-Aircraft Regiment (Lanark and Renfrew) to a light anti-aircraft regiment.

(o) AIR FORCE -

No. 666 Air Observer Post (AOP) Squadron was formed in March but has not yet become operational. This squadron will operate in Fighter Command.

No. 664 and 665 AOP Squadrons became operational in March.
