Ottawa, April 7, 1909.

Madam,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd inst., and in reply I beg to say that, as you did not take charge of the Oka Village school until September 1, last, the Department will, if the school is kept open till the end of June, next, regularly allow you the full years salary. That is, no deduction will be made because the school was a little late in being opened last year. Should you, however, remain in charge of the school next year, it should be reopened after the summer holidays not later than the third Monday in August.
