In accordance with your request of the 21st untimo, I beg to enchose herewith blue print copy of a plan showing the Fort William Indian Reserve.

The portion coloured brown along the Kaministiquia and Mission Rivers is the land which has been sold to the Grand Trunk Pacific Company. You will note that it commences on the West at the road allowance between lots to and II.

The portion hordered green is that part of the Reserve surrendered, in 1859, for sale. Nearly the whole of it has been sold and as you are probably aware the the proceeds have been applied to the benefit of band. The portion bordered red shows the reserve as you now hold it.
