
Ottawa, April 19, 1911.

The Council of the Mississauga band of the Credit, whose reserve is in the Township of Tuscarora, County of Brant, have asked for the appointment of two constables for their reserve and have recommended Samuel Laform and Alfred M. Henry as suitable men to perform the duties of the position. The Indian Agent, Mr. W. C. Van Loon, has reported that the two men mentioned are the best that could be secured at the present time, and has recommended that they be appointed.
