## INTRODUCTION

In presenting these post-war plans, I used the title "Win the Peace and Prevent War" because it has always been my opinion that a war is not won unless we also win the peace that follows in such manner that it shall prevent future war.

This second book, with the sub-title "Total Peace", is really a continuation of Book I, and is intended to show how the International Court, as set forth in Book I, might, through the medium of its Sub-Councils, as herein described, deal with Economic and other international activities which are of major importance, to secure and preserve, by equitable methods, without fear or favour, a future TOTAL PEACE.

In the use of the slogan "Win the War!" it is apparent that too many of our leaders and others overlook the fact that winning a war (i.e.ethe actual fighting) is only the first step towards future world security. To really win, we must win both: War and Peace. If we do not win the peace, then it is obvious that we have lost. As war is won by a definite co-operative organization of men, money, materiel, science, etc., so
