*By His Excellency Sir ALEXANDER
BANNERMAN, Knight, Governor and
Commander-in-Chief in and over
the Island of Newfoundland and
its Dependencies, &c.*

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Pro-
rogued until WEDNESDAY the TWENTY-SECOND day of JUNE
instant: and whereas I think fit to Prorogue the said GENERAL
ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the EIGHTEENTH day of August, next en-
suing: I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue
the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the EIGHTEENTH day
of AUGUST next, as aforesaid: of which all persons concerned are re-
quired and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves
accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Great
Seal of the said Island of New-
foundland, at the Government
House, at St. John's, in the said
Island, this Twenty-first day of
June, 1864, in the Twenty-eighth
Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
