## FRENCH OFFICIAL

By Special Wire to the Courier.

Paris, Oct. 27.—Another attack was made last night by the Germans in the region of La Courtiere, where heavy fighting has been in progress for some time for possession of the German salient. The war office announced today that this attack had been defeated. The statement follows:

"To the south of Loos our aeroplanes drove back and dispersed by their fire strong patrols of the enemy."

"In the Champagne, in the course of the night the Germans attempted a new attack against our trenches at La Courtiere. This attack was checked immediately by our infantry fire and machine guns, and failed completely."

"The night was calm on the rest of the front."

## TRANSPORT SUNK IN AEGEAN SEA

London, Oct. 27.—An Official announcement made public to-day says:

"The British transport Marquette has been torpedoed in the Aegean Sea. It is understood that only 99 of the personnel of the vessel are unaccounted for."

"No further details have been received."

The steamer Marquette, before she was taken into the Government service, was owned by the Atlantic Transport Company, and plied between Philadelphia and Baltimore and London. She was a vessel of some 7,000 tons and was built in Glasgow in 1907.
