BRONX AND THE CHICAGO GAS COMPANIES.

Mr. Watkins, President of the Chicago Gas Light and Coke Company, 'does not anticipate any shortage in the production of gas on the alleged discovery of a means to economically utilize electric light. He has carefully watched the operations of the gas inventor, and is unable to see that a method has been established which will furnish the light to a large number of consumers at a rate which would enter into active competition with the Department of the Company. He has just returned from Paris, where he was sent to examine Jablochoff's electric method. He declares the electric gas is a success, which is the conclusion of the President of the Chicago Gas Company, and he may be able to add that Professor Barrelet, of Chicago, who has largely experimented in electric light, does not place much confidence in Edison's new claim. He avows that the motive power necessary to create a current sufficient to supply a city with light would incur an expense greatly in excess of the price reported for gas.
