Two New York Merchants, Sentenced for Forgery, Ordered Released by Appellate Court-Judges Doubtful if any Crime was Committed.

New York, Nov. 18—An order for the immediate release from Sing Sing prison of Morris Taub and Louis Brown, formerly engaged in the cotton goods business here, as Brown & Taub, was issued tonight by the appellate division of the supreme court.

The men were convicted in February, 1910, by a jury in general sessions and were sentenced by Judge Malone to Sing Sing for not less than two years and six months on a charge of forgery in the third degree.

According to the appellate division, they should not have been prosecuted at all on the charge of forgery, and it appears to be a case of grave doubt if any offense warranting criminal prosecution was committed. It was charged by the district attorney's office that Brown and an entry in their ledger of \$26,345.84, which purported to indicate that the share of Brown in the business was \$5,787.32."

The order of the court will be taken to Sing Sing tomorrow by a lawyer.


