used to handling a gun, be careful! The first thing to remember is that in fact, only two safe positions for

your gun-barrels.
One is pointing skyward, and the other pointing at the earth. Three-fourths of the gun accidents every year occur because people concentrate their attention upon the triggers instead of remembering where the gun

For instance, if you are inexperienced you will probably make your first mistake in loading. Having opened the breech, you slip in two cartleft hand while holding the stock with your right.

This is unsafe and wrong, because by snapping up the barrels you cause the gun to point in a very dangerous ine namely, on a level with the ablomen of anyone who happens to be standing by. Guns have been known to go off when loaded in this way, and serious accidents have resulted.




