KILLED SAME DAY**

GUELPH, Dec. 5.—Never since the start of the war has this city received such a shock as today when it became known that seven Guelph boys had been living in the city for some years past to enlisting. The latter is a native of Cornwall, but had been living in Paris, where he was well known. Younall's parents moved to this city about a year ago.
