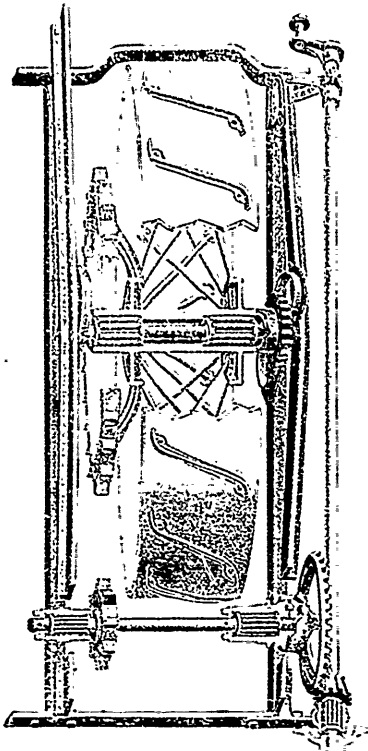


THE Massey-Harris Wide-Open BINDER
