Messrs. T. & T. Clark's recent issues in the Foreign Theological Library embrace Prof. Kiel's Commentary on Daniel and the Book of Kings. They have ready two new volumes of the Works of St. Augustine; the Completion of the Anti-Nicene Library series; a Biblio-Theological Lexicon of New Testament Greek, and a collected volume of Sermons by the late Principal Cunningham.

#### AMERICAN.

Messrs. Harper Brothers' issues for the month embrace reprints of Palmer's "The Desert of the Exodus," being journeyings on foot in the wilderness of the forty years' wanderings, undertaken in connection with the Ordnance Survey of Sinai and the Palestine Exploration Fund; "Annual Record of Science and Industry for 1871"; Talmage's Sermons delivered in the Brooklyn Tabernacle; and the re-publication of Charles Lever's current novel, "Lord Kilgobbin."

Messrs. D. Appleton & Co. have ready a cheaper edition of "South Sea Bubbles," a book of travel in Polynesia, by the author-peer, Earl Pembroke; a new revised edition of Sir Charles Lyell's "Principles of Geology," volume I.; and "Life in Nature," by James Hinton, author of "Man and His Dwelling Place," also recently published by them.

Messrs. Scribner, Armstrong & Co. publish a new volume of Lange's Commentary, viz.: on Kings. They reprint Dean Stanley's recent lectures, delivered in Edinburgh, on the Church of Scotland; and a new historical novel on the recent war, entitled, "A Miller's Story of the War, or the Plehiscite."

Messrs. Hurd & Houghton, having reference to the recent deaths of Mazzini and Prof. Maurice, issue a biography of the former with a disquisition on his writings and political principles; and of the latter, they reprint the sermons preached in the Chapel of Lincoln's Inn on "The Lord's Prayer." This firm also re-issue two works of Prin. Shairp of St. Andrew's—his "Studies in Poetry and Philosophy," and a treatise on "Culture and Religion."

Messrs. J. R. Osgood & Co. announce Robert Browning's new volume, "Fifine at the Fair," and which will include his recent poems, "Herve Riel," "Balaustion's Adventure," and "Prince Hohensteil-Schwangau." Also a new volume from Mr. Longfellow, embracing a continuation of "Tales of a Wayside Inn," a long poem, "Judas Maccabaeus," and a handful of translations.
