ii) whether goods exported from the territory of one Party have been lawfully imported into the territory of the other Party and the customs procedure used for clearing the goods;

iii) the movement of goods, vessels, vehicles, and aircraft between the territories of the Parties.

ARTICLE VII

Suppression of Illicit Traffic in Narcotics and Psychotropic Substances

The Customs Administrations of the two Parties, for the purpose of aiding, within the scope of their respective mandates in the suppression of illicit traffic in narcotics and psychotropic substances, will communicate with each other to the extent possible, on their own initiative and without delay, all information regarding possible violations of the customs laws of the other Party.

ARTICLE VIII

Obligation to Observe Confidentiality

 Inquiries, information, documents and other communications received by the Customs Administration of either Party under this Agreement shall be treated as
