- (iv) Share equally with the Government of Canada the cost of temporary communications facilities, for an estimated period of six months, required to establish the Loran-A rate between Gray Point and Biorka.
- (v) Carry out the necessary mapping changes to the United States Government published maps.
- (vi) Provide flight checking facilities to permit the initial accuracy check, the costs of which shall be shared equally by each Government.

Each Government will operate and maintain their respective Loran-A Stations aforesaid at their own cost and expense and will not remove or decommission the stations until the expiration of one year's notice, in writing, by one party to the other, the notice by the Government of Canada to be given on or on behalf of the Minister of Transport and to be mailed addressed to the Commandant United States Coast Guard, Washington, D.C. 20591, at any of Her Majesty's Post Offices.

I therefore have the honour to propose that, if the foregoing terms and conditions are acceptable to your Government, this Note, which is authentic in English and in French, and your reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply. This Agreement shall remain in force until July 1, 1971 and therefore until terminated by either party on one year's notice in writing ^{to} the other.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
