EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA CONCERNING THE COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF AN AREA OF THE UNITED STATES NAVAL STATION, ARGENTIA, NEWFOUNDLAND

Sir:

I have the honour to refer to recent discussions between officials of the Embassy and your Department concerning commercial development of an area of the United States Naval Station, Argentia, Newfoundland. The Station is leased by the United States Government under the Leased Naval and Air Bases Agreement of March 27, 1941⁽¹⁾, as amended. The United States Government proposes that the Government of Canada sublease and occupy the area of the United States Naval Station, described in Annex A and depicted in Annex B of this Note, for commercial and other purposes, for and during a term commencing on the 6th day of June, 1978 and continuing up to and including the 25th day of March, 2040, subject, however, to the terms and conditions set forth in Annex C.

I have further the honour to propose that, if the arrangements outlined in this Note with its attached Annexes A, B and C, are acceptable to your Government, this Note together with its Annexes, and your reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
