I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of Your Excellency's Note No. 151 of this date, in which you have transmitted the proposal of the Government of Canada to renew for one more year the commercial modus vivendi between Venezuela and Canada, signed in Caracas on October 11, 1950, (1) and renewed for one year, on October 11, 1951, (2) by means of an exchange of Notes.

In reply, I am pleased to inform Your Excellency that I have been authorized by my Government to agree to the proposed renewal.

As suggested by Your Excellency, your Note, together with this reply, will be considered as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments to renew the said modus vivendi under the same terms, until October 11, 1953.
