2. What is a list of all grants made under the Open House Canada Program since its inception and up to the date that this question is answered, to the former constituency of Leeds and the present constituency of Leeds-Grenville and what was the total amount granted under the program?

#### DREE—MATAPÉDIA—MATANE

##### Question No. 157—Mr. Cossitt:

1. Did the Minister of Regional Economic Expansion announce a DREE grant for the constituency of Matapédia—Matane after becoming minister and, if so (a) how many days after he was appointed minister was the announcement made and on what date (b) what was the amount?

2. How many other grants have been announced or are under consideration for the constituency?

**Hon. Pierre De Bané (Minister of Regional Economic Expansion):** The reply for the Department of Regional Economic Expansion is as follows:

1. (a) On March 10, 1980, seven days after his appointment, the Minister of Regional Economic Expansion announced the offer of a grant to Pic-Bois Inc., an offer accepted by the company on February 11, 1980.

(b) \$84,200.

#### CHIP

##### Question No. 159—Mr. Cossitt:

1. Does the CHIP application state that the grant only covers one-third of the labour costs of installing insulation if the work is done by a contractor and, if not, does the government plan to issue new applications stating that the grant will only cover work done by contractors?

2. Will the CHIP grant be paid for labour costs incurred by individuals not considered contractors and, if not, for what reason?

**Hon. Paul J. Cosgrove (Minister of Public Works):** I am advised by Canada Mortgage and Housing as follows:

1. This information is not in the present application form nor is it included in the revised version. However, this information will be provided in the related brochure.

2. CHIP grants will be paid for the labour costs charged by individuals as well as contractors, providing the invoice clearly indicates the name of the installer, his address, telephone number, details of work done, date work done, and amount received for work done.
