FIRST SEDERUNT.

*At Toronto, and within Knox Church there ; Thursday, the eighth day
of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy six years :—*

Which day the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada met according to appointment. The Retiring Moderator, the Rev. John Cook, D.D., Minister of St. Andrew's Church, Quebec, conducted Divine Service and preached a sermon from Ephesians iv., 18 : "Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ."

Thereafter, the General Assembly was constituted with prayer by the said Rev. Dr. Cook.
