

receive daily from the Guards. The importance of having correct time kept by all parties can not be too strongly insisted on.

17. Each officer shall make himself thoroughly acquainted with all Time-Tables and Special Rules which may be made from time to time, and shall keep a copy of the same on his person when on duty, as well as a copy of these Regulations, under a penalty of ten shillings for each neglect.

18. Each Conductor, Baggage Master, and Brakeman, while on duty, shall wear upon his hat or cap a badge which shall indicate his office.

19. Each officer or employe of the Railway is prohibited from smoking while on duty in the cars, stations, or depots.

20. They are also strictly forbidden from taking charge of any letters or parcels uninvoyced, except those belonging exclusively to the Railway service.

21. Employes disapproving of these Regulations, or not disposed to aid in carrying them out, are requested not to remain in the Railway service.
