keeping 1, until ers will receive daily from the Guards. The importance of having correct time kept by all parties can not be too strongly insisted on.

- 17. Each officer shall make himself thoroughly acquainted with all Time-Tables and Special Rules which may be made from time to time, and shall keep a copy of the same on his person when on duty, as well as a copy of these Regulations, under a penalty of ten shillings for each neglect.
- 18. Each Conductor, Baggage Master, and Brakeman, while on duty, shall wear upon his hat or cap a badge which shall indicate his office.
- 19. Each officer or employe of the Railway is prohibited from smoking while on duty in the cars, stations, or depots.
- 20. They are also strictly forbidden from taking charge of any letters or parcels uninvoiced, except those belonging exclusively to the Railway service.
- 21. Employes disapproving of these Regulations, or not disposed to aid in carrying them out, are requested not to remain in the Railway service.
