Buffalo, N.Y., Sept. 14.—Funeral formalities and the outward manifestations of a nation's grief are all that now remain. With these over, the curtain falls on the third great tragedy in the annals of American Presidents, and that tragedy and the career of William McKinley pass into history.

Already the machinery of the executive branch of the government has resumed its routine. By a brief ceremony, deeply impressive from its simple dignity, Theodore Roosevelt this afternoon became the President of the United States and the seat of government was established for the brief interval between now and Monday morning in the stately old home of Ansley Wilcox, 641 Delaware avenue, which now has become the Buffalo White House.

Chicago General Agents Place It at \$65,000.

THE STEEL STRIKE IS SETTLED

MEN RETURN TO WORK ON MONDAY

Agreement Was Not Made Public, But Is Signed By the Interested Parties on Both Sides—Three of the Big Concerns Are in the Arrangement.

New York, Sept. 14.—The great steel strike, which began on June 30, was brought to an end in a conference held today between the leaders of the Amalgamated Association and officers of the subsidiary companies of the United States Steel Corporation.

An agreement was signed under which the men will return to work in the mills that have been idle on Monday morning. This announcement was made at the offices of the American Tin Plate Company, where the conference was held.

The full terms of the settlement were not divulged, and it was announced that this was in accordance with an agreement between the parties to the conference. It was necessary that no knowledge of the transfer should become public.

For three hours the strike situation was discussed, and it was agreed that the men would return to work on Monday morning. The agreement was signed by the interested parties on both sides.
