

Should the epidemic become even more widespread than it is across the line, the United States cattle trade would find an outlet in the United States dead meat industry. Even in case Great Britain entirely shut off all livestock imports from the United States, the Americans could still send over their animals in the shape of dead meat.

But Canada is in a different and much less advantageous position. Should the epidemic get into this country, Great Britain would place an absolutely prohibitive embargo on all our export cattle, and the effect of such an embargo would be most disastrous to a trade that is worth \$10,000,000 to the Dominion.
