Reaction at Chicago, However, Follows Advances in Both Corn and Oats.

Chicago, June 3.—Corn ruled higher in price most of the time today as a result of continued traffic difficulties, but the market became over-bought. The close was nervous 1c to 2 1/2c net lower, with July 17 1/2 to 17 3/4, and September 16 1/2 to 17 1/8, and October 15 1/2 to 16 1/8, and provisions varying from 7c decline to 10c advance.
