- Yes, Sir.
  - And you told my learned friend here that you were on your way back?
  - Yes, Sir.
  - Hitch-hiking back?
  - Yes. Sir.
  - Q You weren't hitch-hiking anywhere else, were you?
  - No; on the main line, No. 1 Highway.
- Had you any money?
- I had about four dollars.
- And you got as far as Broadview?
- Yes, Sir.
- How did they find you in Broadview?
- I was in uniform, Sir.
- Whereabouts did the Police contact you?
- Well. I was on the street waiting for a ride.
- And the Police asked you for a pass, or something?
- It was four o'clock in the morning, and he asked me for my pass.
- And you told them what you had done, did you?
- Yes, Sir.
- Did you explain exactly the whole thing that you had done?
- Yes, Sir.
- Where were you actually heading for then?
- Heading back to Camp Shilo, Sir.
- Q And you had your uniform on?
- Yes, Sir.
- You intended to return, did you?
- Yes, Sir.

Re-examined by the Defending Officer:

- How long were you at home the last time previous to your ninety-
- I was home about four hours. Wy kid was born on January 14th, and I went home for four hours.
- And you didn't decide then to build the house, did you?
- Well, No; not just then.
- In other words, you were in a hurry and you didn't have time to think snything about it, did you?

  No. Sir.
