2. MARQUIS OF LANSDOWNE MEDAL.

His Excellency the Marquis of Lansdowne, having presented a Silver Medal for annual competition, it will be awarded to the Student of the second year, who, having taken first Class Honors in the College Examinations in one Department, and First or Second-Class Honors in another Department, shall rank highest. The relative proficiency of different candidates is estimated on the Honor work of the two Departments alone.
