Rowing Notes. The Boston Globe of Monday says the following: Reports from various sections of the country show that unusual preparations are being made even at this early date for the next rowing season.

It was known in professional rowing circles last season that while training Rumour at New York for the national regatta, Eddie Duran took quite a fancy to him, and they now form a double team.

Among the latest arrivals in town is Frank Reddock, son of the late W. Reddock, the shell boat builder. He reports that there is a great boom in boat construction in all classes, and expects to close with several local parties for boats.

The Unions will have a four-oared shell for their crew, and Sculler Henderson, who rowed so fast last season, will have a new single. The St. Joseph's are also to have a four-oared shell. Harry Vail, coach of the Newell Boat Club of Harvard, has ordered a single, three crew.

Lynch's boat will be a single, and it will be on the list. This means a whole lot of racing in this vicinity, and owners will be interested in the first race between the St. Joseph's and the Unions.

This is one of the chief faults found by Coach Pat Donovan in the men that try for the World crew, and it will be remedied at the B. A. A.

To be sure, the old boats will do duty for practice ships and the lighter ones will be held in reserve for the racing. Edward Hanlan was outspoken in his condemnation of the boats now used by the scholastic rowmen.

Mr. Watford of the B. A. A. is also a strong advocate of the lighter crafts, and his plans are to have five of them built, but before this can be done the school must give financial assistance.

The plan is to have the same schools row as they did last season from B. A. A., and the Unions are expected to lend a hand and take the clubs they had last spring.
