feet upon the ground and close together,
the left a couple of inches further back,
with the heel very slightly raised. A mo
ment before she was erect, but she has
dropped into an easier position, with the
left knee bent forward and inward against
the right. Her left hand is resting on
the knot of hair at the back of her head,
while her right holds the fillet she has
already passed several times round it.
In doing this she has swayed a little over
and down to the right, bringing the left
side forward. The shoulders are well
set back, and the face is turned to the
right and a little downward, showing
from the front a not quite three-quarter
view. It is thought that the statue will
take rank above the Medicean Venus.
