shall think fit; and if any master or mate fails so to deliver Penalty on his certificate when so required, he shall incur a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds; but no certificate shall be cancelled or suspended unless a copy of the report, or a statement of the case upon which the investigation is ordered, has been furnished to the owner of the certificate before the commencement of the investigation: provided always, that nothing in this Act contained shall be taken to affect, in any way, the jurisdiction of the Vice Admiralty Court of this Island, howsoever the same may be acquired.
