The members of the Executive Council, being members of the House, are ordered to report the time when His Excellency will be pleased to be attended with the address.

8. At the opening of each session, the Librarian reports to the House, through the Speaker, the actual state of the Library.

On the second Friday after the commencement of each session, the House is called, and notice is taken of such Life Members as are absent without the permission of Her Majesty or of the Governor of this Province, signified to the House; and on this occasion the Committee of privileges reports to the House the names of such Legislative Councillors as may have died since the last session, or who may appear to have vacated their seats by absence or otherwise.
