

An Act for the construction of Water Works in the Village of Terrebonne.

WHEREAS great advantages would result to the inhabitants of the Village of Terrebonne from the construction of Water works therein: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. The Municipal Council of the Village of Terrebonne is hereby authorized to pass a By-law for the construction of Water Works, and for that purpose to construct without as well as within the limits of the Municipality, the aqueducts which will be required, and to take possession of the land necessary therefor without the consent of the proprietors, and to do all such things as may be necessary and expedient for the purpose of furnishing the inhabitants of the said Village with pure water. Council of Terrebonne may construct Water Works, &c.

II. The Municipal Council shall have power to impose upon the inhabitants of the Municipality all taxes and obligations that may be necessary or requisite in order to the construction and keeping in repair of the said Water Works. Power to tax, &c.

15 III. Any indemnity for real property taken, or damage thereto, if any such shall have been occasioned, either within or without the limits of the Municipality, shall be determined in accordance with the Municipal Act, and the said Act shall apply wherever it can be made applicable, to all proceedings that may be taken to attain the object of this Act.
