

and eleven pence halfpenny, for reimbursing to the Province of Massachusetts Bay, their Expences in furnishing Provisions and Stores to the Troops raised by them for His Majesty's Service, for the Campaign in the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty six; and any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Thirteen thousand seven hundred thirty six pounds, seventeen shillings, and seven pence, for reimbursing to the Colony of Connecticut, their Expences in furnishing Provisions and Stores to the Troops raised by them for His Majesty's Service, for the Campaign in the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty six; and any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Twenty thousand pounds, upon Account, to be paid to the United Company of Merchants of England trading to the East Indies, towards enabling them to defray the Expence of a Military Force in their Settlements, to be maintained by them in lieu of the Battalion of His Majesty's Forces, withdrawn from those Settlements; and the Sum of Four thousand pounds for repairing the Parish Church of Saint Margaret Westminster; and any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Ten thousand pounds, to be employed in maintaining and supporting the British Forts and Settlements upon the Coast of Africa.

And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That the said Aids and Supplies provided as aforesaid, shall not be issued or applied to any Use, Intent, or Purpose whatsoever, other than the Uses and Purposes before mentioned, or for the several Deficiencies, or other Payments, directed to be satisfied thereout, by any Act or Acts, or any particular Clause or Clauses for that Purpose contained in any other Act or Acts of this present Session of Parliament.

And, as to the said Sum of Thirty five thousand six hundred and two Pounds by this Act appropriated on Account of Half-pay as aforesaid, it is hereby enacted and declared by the Authority aforesaid, That the Rules herein after prescribed, shall be duly observed in the Application of the said Half-pay; that is to say, That no Person shall have or receive any Part of the same, who was a Minor, and under the Age of Sixteen Years, at the Time when the Regiment, Troop, or Company, in which he served, was reduced; that no Person shall have or receive any Part of the same, except such Person who did actual Service in some Regiment, Troop, or Company; that no Person having any other Place or Employment of Profit, Civil or Military, under His Majesty, shall have or receive any Part of the said Half-pay; that no Chaplain of any Garrison or Regiment, who has any
