Mr. McLean,

Will you please let me know what is being done with regard to the purchase of wood lands for the Indians in Pictou, N.S. Last year we had an appropriation for this purpose. I do not know whether anything has been done this year or not but Mr. Bell, M.P., advises me that the Indians are likely to get into trouble from the fact that they take wood off of lands other than those belonging to them, and he thinks another vote should be put in this year for this purpose. Please let me know if anything has been recommended or not.
