	Dec 28 1940		LAC L.J. Webster 404123 returns to No. 3 S.F.T.S. at 1100 hours. Accident to aircraft 9929 during formation flying. F/L E.S. Holmes C.1292 departs for Lethbridge in Anson 1641 at 1203 hours. Arrives back at 1620 hours.	
	Dec 29 "		Flying continues all day.	
	Dec 30 "		S/L N.B. Petersen C.170 visited the C.O. this morning and advises him that Class 14 is three weeks behind schedule due to lack of aircraft. With Class 10 flying steadily it would appear difficult to make up this lost time unless more aircraft are forthcoming. Heavy fog and no flying today.	
	Dec 31 "		Flying continued until noon. Closed down for the holiday. We have 92 trainees under instruction in this squadron. Total aircraft 23, two having been turned over to No. 2 squadron. It has been a splendid month for flying, only 22:30 hours having been lost in the month. Lack of aircraft have been the limiting factor.
