Halton (Continued)

JULY 13th

Organizer W.H.Adams visited Burlington to-day and conferred with President Fisher and Miss Stuart, sister of W.J. Stuart the organizer for Halton. Miss Stuart appears to have full information as to Mr. Stuart's movements. President Fisher stated that the revision would be made complete.

JULY 15th

Organizer W.J.Stuart reports that he has been giving attention to Milton lists which was posted up on June 19th. 21 names at present to be removed from the list in Milton and 42 names to be added. Stuart requests more forms and says he will be glad to have organizer Adams call and see him at Burlington.

JULY 19th

Local organizer Wm.J.Stuart reports Milton list attended to. Forty names to add and eighteen to strike off. Nassagaweya Township list posted on 15th July. Acton will be posted soon.

JULY 22nd.

Local organizer William J.Stuart reports that organizer Adams conferred with him in Burlington to-day. Acton list was posted on July 19th.

AUGUSTA 20th

Local Organizer William J.Stuart asks for additional forms and reports that Nelson Township was posted July 29th and Burlington Village and Esquesing were posted on August 10th and reports that they have revised Milton Town, Nassagaweya and Acton Village.

AUGUST 28th

Organizer W.J.Stuart requests 100 more affidavits by Claimant to attend to Burlington and Esquesing. He reports that Nelson Township is completed.

SEPTEMBER 22nd

William J.Stuart reports that Georgetown list was posted on September 6th. Had four Courts of Revision last week Milton, Acton, Nassagaweya and Nelson with good results. Oakville list is not yet posted
