



Ottawa, 8th February, 1911.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, reporting the shortage of hay for cattle belonging to Frenchman's Head Band, and in reply I beg to say that this Band has no funds to which the cost of the necessary hay could be charged. If you report the approximate cost of the quantity required it is thought that the Department may be able to make the necessary advance to purchase the hay, provided the Indians are willing that the said cost shall be charged against their annuity money. Your further report in this matter will be expected.
