In these circumstances, in view of the pledge of the French Government contained in their note of July 9th, the Polish Government, conscious of their grave responsibility for preserving the Polish National Gold Reserve, would be grateful to the Canadian Government for such assistance which would enable the Polish Government to obtain the equivalent of the Polish gold from the French gold deposited in Canada.
