to work as a Blacksmith if he can get a  
reasonable allowance from this Government  
for the same and has occasion for a  
Blanket or 2 yd of Strouds, 2. Shirts & one  
of Stockings of which offer the Com<sup>rs</sup>  
accepted and gave another to A. Plukin  
Livingston to deliver the said Prigdon  
of <sup>the</sup> Store left in hand by His <sup>the</sup> Excellency

or ~~order~~ that Lawrence be <sup>sent</sup> forthwith  
to Oneida Country to meet & see Sugdon  
there & that the following Instruction  
shall be give.

Instructions for Lawrence the Interpreter  
who is to go from hence with Sam Hgedorn  
to post in one yd. to work for the Five  
Nations pursuant to His Excellency  
order for the time & space of two y<sup>rs</sup> till  
further order from His the Service shall require
