Re: Masset Indian Day School

I am recommending the appointment of Miss Sarah Freeman and Miss Gwen Coleman to the above-mentioned school. As Miss Freeman and Miss Coleman are friends, it will be an advantage in accommodating them in the rented teacherage at Masset.

Miss Freeman formerly taught at Sunnyside Day School and it is possible that you are already acquainted with her. Although she has no certificate, her services at Sunnyside were very satisfactory.

Miss Coleman is also uncertificated but has had a similar training to Miss Freeman. I believe that both of them will be better than poor certificated teachers. Although I normally leave the assigning of teachers to their respective Grades, I would ask you to suggest to Mr. Day that Miss Freeman take charge of the beginners and that Miss Coleman take the other class.
