- 33. St. Paul wrote a number of Epistles. These were letters. Of these he wrote nine to churches and four to persons. St. Peter also wrote two Epistles, and St. James and St. Jude one each.
- 34. All the Apostles, except St. John, were put to death. He lived to be about 100 years old. He wrote a Gospel, three Epistles and Revelation. The last thing told us in the Bible is that Jesus is coming back again. We keep Advent season in remembrance of this promise.
